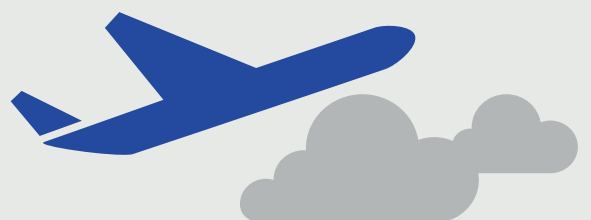
We provide pharma-protective solutions for pharmaceutical and biotech companies who transport time and temperature sensitive goods by air.
